

2022 Bridge Conference Attendee Guidance Checklist

Get ready for the Bridge Conference on Oct. 23-24, 2022 by taking the following actions.

- Be prepared to wear a mask at the Conference except while eating or drinking.**
 - To center those most vulnerable in our community, the Bridge Conference has a universal masking policy. **Everyone is required to wear a mask inside our two venues except while eating or drinking.** Presenters may be unmasked while presenting. Masks will be provided for those who do not bring their own.

- Plan your route, including knowing the location details and parking information.**
 - There is street parking and a [parking lot](#) on site at the Greater Tacoma Convention Center for a fee. This [map](#) is a useful tool to identify nearby lots.

 - If you're joining us for breakfast, we strongly recommend you arrive by 8:30 a.m. so that you have time to eat and mask up before sessions begin at 9 a.m.
 - Breakfast, boxed lunches, and afternoon snacks are provided, with ingredients listed.
 - Participants may eat socially distanced by taking their meal to one of 5 rooms in the GTCC.
